



Getting started with the GrandStream BudgeTone IP Phone and GlobeFone VoIP calling service.

### GrandStream BudgeTone IP Phone Introduction:

The GrandStream BudgeTone is a VoIP telephone which is designed to look and feel like a standard home telephone but uses GlobeFone's high quality VoIP calling network to let you place calls worldwide affordably and conveniently. The BudgeTone telephone comes pre-configured with GlobeFone network settings. All you need to do is connect the phone to an internet/ethernet connection via the LAN port at the back of the phone and start making phone calls.

### Internet Sharing feature:

Got only one internet connection ? No problem. The BudgeTone IP Phone has a built-in internet connection splitter so you can share your internet connection with your computer. Just connect your internet/ethernet cable to the **LAN** port of the phone and connect your computer to the **PC** port of the phone with an ethernet cable (RJ-45). The Phone will split the connection and let you use the phone and your computer at the same time.

### How to place calls.

The BudgeTone IP Phone is already configured to let you place calls with the GlobeFone VoIP service. All you need to do is connect the power supply to the phone (power adapter included) and connect your phone to an internet connection (using the ethernet RJ-45 cable included). You are all set to place phone calls.

1. Pick up the hand set of the phone.
2. You will hear a welcome message. You will be prompted to enter your destination phone number.
3. The format of entering the phone number is :

Country Code + Area Code + Phone Number + #

**Note:** You must press the pound key (#) at the end of each phone number. No 011 prefix is required. You can press the pound key twice (##) to disconnect your call or simply hang-up the phone.
